WELCOME

We had <u>25</u> members and guests present at the meeting. Brent opened the meeting by welcoming everyone. He then introduced the guest speaker, Nick Deboer.

GUEST SPEAKER - Nick Deboer, Service Manager.

Nick spoke of tire safety. Underinflation is the worst thing for tires – it can cause cupping; excessive wear and the tread could potentially fall off. He recommended that everyone check tire pressure at least one a week. Tread is another element to check. If your tread is at or below 3/32 its time to get new tires.

When looking at new tires, especially if purchasing online, check the date code and don't get tires older than 3 years. The date of manufacture is the last four digits of the DOT code. The first two digits are the week of manufacture, and the last two digits are the year. For example, if the last four digits of the DOT code are 4516, that means that the tire was manufactured during the 45th week of the year 2016.

It is recommended that you not have different brands of tires on the bike. Tires are designed and built to work as a set. The tread designs themselves complement one another when dealing with dispersing water and with mechanical grip. The internal constructions of the tires front and rear are different (due to the geometrical and physical characteristics of a moving motorcycle), yet they also complement one another. Note that normally, rear to front tire wear is 2:1.

He went on to say that for people who want nitrogen in their tires, CHD is able to help out. The benefits of using nitrogen include extended tire life, better pressure retention, and thus improved fuel economy and more

reliable handling. Tires should be filled with nitrogen to the same pressure that is recommended by the manufacturer for air.

Dyna Beads dynamically balance tires on the move, resulting in a smoother ride, and one that lasts the life of the tire. Dyna Beads are small ceramic spheres, high in density and perfectly smooth, that travel inside the tire to locate themselves opposite heavy points to eliminate out-of-balance motion. However, CHD doesn't recommend their use as other issues have been discovered due to their use.
